
Kuranda Visitors Information Centre

Scope:

This modern new build welcomes countless visitors to the picturesque village of Kuranda, aptly named "The Village in the Rainforest".

Built in a village park, this build required sensitivity to the existing surroundings. Care was taken during demolition to recover sculptured handrails, painted pavers, a flag pole, a stone plaque and also stone from the existing garden edges and park apron. Once the build was completed, stone facing was applied to external masonry walls, brick paving and borders were reinstated, exposed aggregate footpaths created and new stone walls built. Turf and surrounding garden areas were re-established.

With its extensive windows, Hi Light Louvre Aluminium screens & framing and polished concrete floor, the building is an open, well-lit structure. All joinery (including display boxes, shelving, kitchenette, reception desk, lockable storage etc.) were custom-made to complete the look and functionality of this popular information centre.
